SUBJECT: Increase in User Fees for Fiscal Year 2020

There will be an increase in user fees starting October 1st, 2019 per 19 CFR 24.22.

CBP User Fee for commercial vessels will be **\$468.32**, with a calendar year cap of **\$6,381.77**

CBP User Fee for barges/bulk carriers arriving from CA or MX will be **\$117.18**, with a calendar year cap of **\$1607.50**.

Customs Broker Permit User Fee will be **\$147.89**.

Informal Entry or Releases; Automated and Not prepared by CBP Personnel **\$2.14**.

Informal Entry or Release; Manual and Not Prepared by CBP Personnel **\$6.43**.

Informal Entry or Releases; Automated or Manual/ Prepared by CBP Personnel **\$9.64**.
