TO: Maritime Exchange Membership

U.S. Customs & Border Protection extended the travel ban at the U.S./Canada and U.S./Mexico border ports of entry through May 20, 2020. Such travel is limited to essential travel.

The restrictions went into effect on April 21, 2020 and remain effective until 11:59 p.m. EDT on May 20, 2020.

Essential travelers include, among several others:

- U.S. citizens and lawful permanent residents returning to the U.S.
- Individuals engaged in lawful cross-border trade (e.g., truck drivers supporting the movement of cargo between the U.S. and Canada and the U.S. and Mexico)

The notification currently does not apply to air, freight rail, or sea travel between the U.S. and Canada and the U.S. and Mexico, but does apply to passenger rail and ferry travel.
