TO: Maritime Operations Committee Member Terminal Operators

CBP Philadelphia issued <u>Pipeline 010-2020</u> to ensure the safety and well-being of individuals who may be exposed to an ill vessel crewmember or vessel passenger. Vessel agents are required to notify CBP prior to a vessel's arrival if there is any vessel crewmember or passenger on-board displaying possible signs of illness.

View the Pipeline for the information CBP will need prior to the vessel arrival.
